The Learning Ally Data Manager<sup>\*</sup> is responsible for understanding and leading integration with the Learning Ally Audiobook Solution. The Data Manager typically has access to a district's or school's student information system, learning management system or other data source and has experience leading integration with SSO and rostering providers or exporting and importing data files for account creation, updating, and login to student and educator facing applications.

Data Managers receive system emails that are relevant to integration.

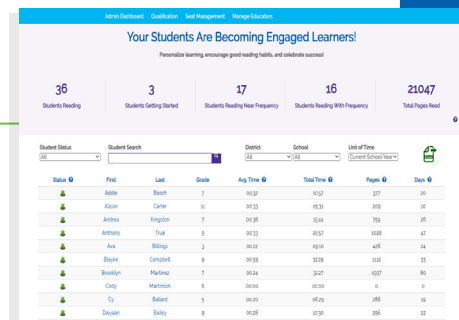

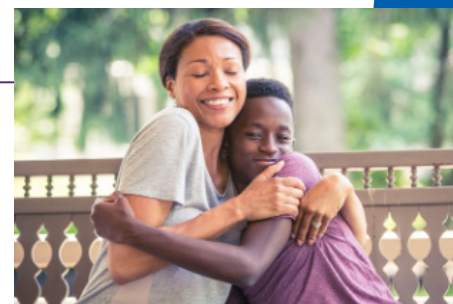
