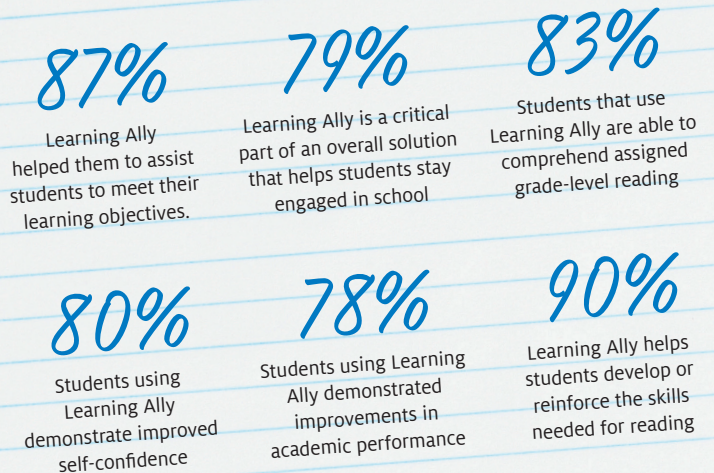
GROWTH IN SCHOOLS 2013-2016

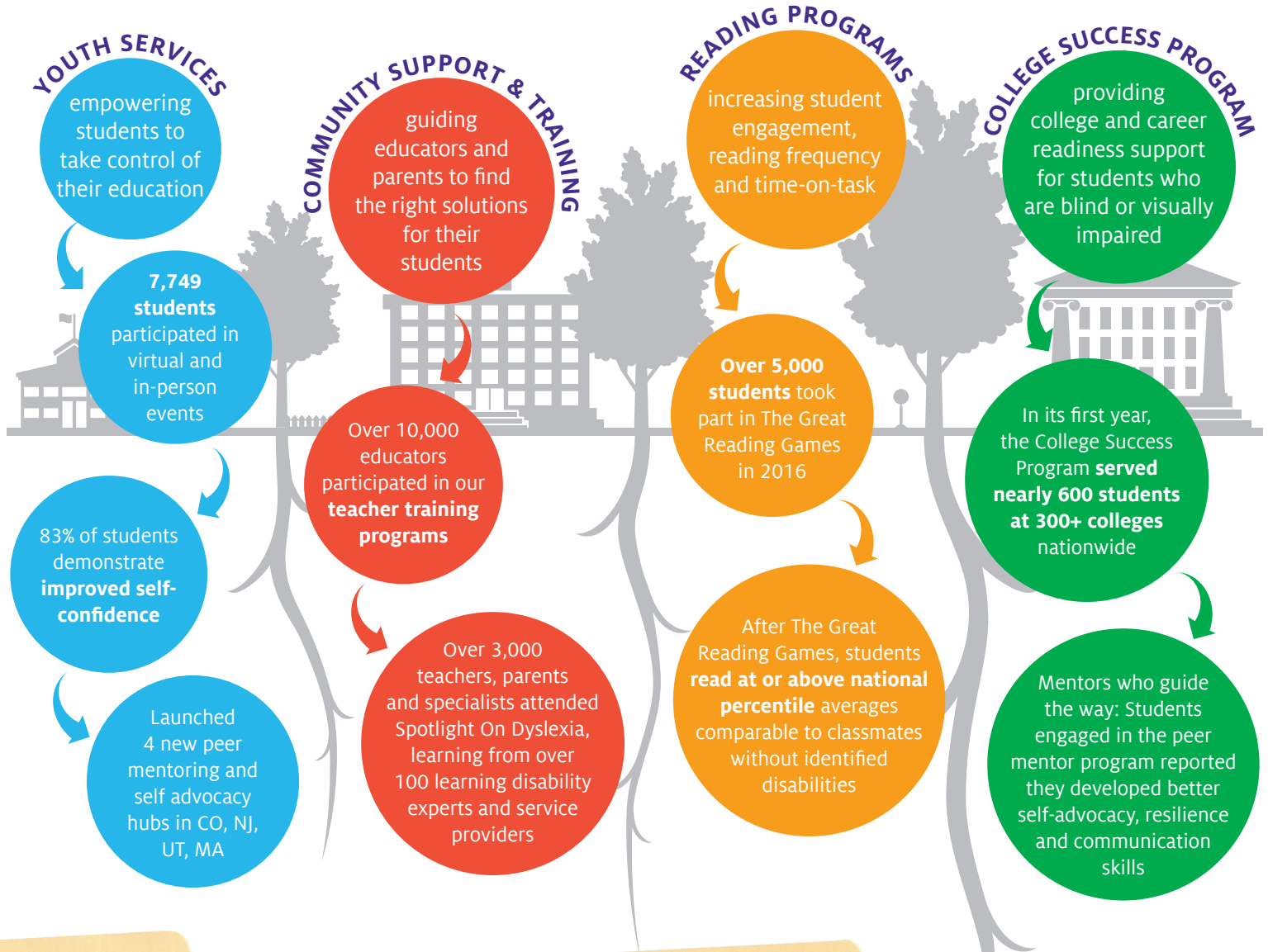
We partner with schools, educators and families, to provide tools that support students' individual learning styles, offering easy access to content in ways each student needs to learn.
