PARTS OF SPEECH

Noun

A word that indicates a person, place or thing

EXAMPLE:

The <u>driver</u> got into his <u>car</u> for a trip.

Verb

A word that indicates action in a sentence

EXAMPLE:

The artist <u>paints</u> portraits for a living.

- Verb+ing: painting
- Verb+ed: painted

Adjective

A word that describes or gives information about the noun

EXAMPLE:

The <u>hungry</u> man went to a restaurant.

Adverb

A word that describes a verb, adjective or another adverb. It explains how, when, where, and to what extent.

EXAMPLE:

He scribbled his notes furiously in his notebook. (verb)

The table was <u>fairly</u> sturdy after fixing the legs. (adjective)

The boy ran $\underline{\text{very}}$ quickly. (adverb)
